## How will the MiFID2 Manager help me?

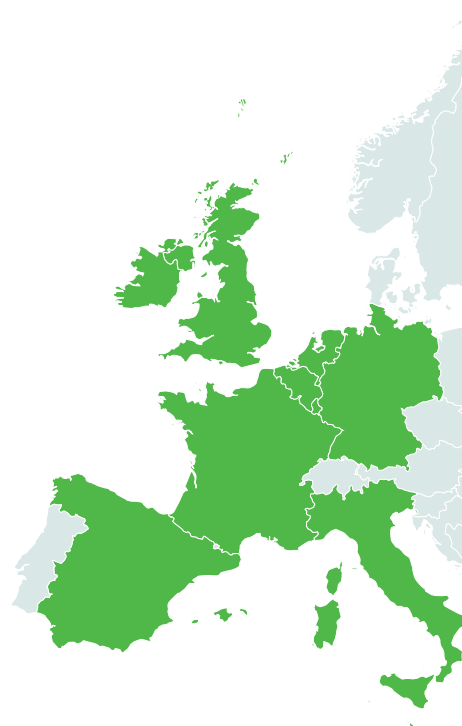
The consultation and transposition process in all of these jurisdictions is also tracked, enabling the MiFID2 Manager to meet the needs of firms operating throughout Europe.
